**Policies**

**1. PREREQUISITES:** Prerequisites for each course listed in the catalog are strictly enforced. It is not sufficient if you have taken the course before. You must have received a grade of “C” or better in the course(s) listed as prerequisite(s). GATE course requirements are listed in the catalog and require the designated GPA.

**2. ACADEMIC DISHONESTY:** All students enrolled in courses taught by the Computer Science and Engineering Department are advised that unless an instructor specifies otherwise, all work done in homework, programming, or exams must be the result of a student’s individual effort. Students, who copy, or who provide material for others to copy, or who show dishonesty in their work as described in the university catalog, will be subject to disciplinary action, typically the receipt of a failing grade in the course, but also possible academic dismissal from the program.

**3. COMPUTER AND NETWORK USE:** The computing and network facilities in the department, college and university are a vital component of the academic environment. The purpose of these facilities is the support of teaching and research by its authorized users. Each person using these resources must be considerate of other users.

Each student must maintain a Computer Science and Engineering email account for official broadcasts distributed by faculty and/or staff.

Any activity which intentionally impedes the legitimate use of the computing and network facilities by other people shall be grounds for immediate suspension of all computing privileges, expulsion from the department and/or recommendation for expulsion from USF. Specifically a student must not:

- a. Provide access to USF's network and computing resources to any other person or entity.
- b. Access another user's account and/or misrepresent one's identity.
- c. Allow another person to access the student’s account or share the password.
- d. Use computing resources for private profit, or for promoting a religious or political group.
- e. Using facilities, including printers, for junk mail, mass mailing, or non-course-related work.
